GCSE Results

Despite the changes to the syllabus and content for GCSE English Language, English Literature and Maths this summer, our student and staff have risen to the challenge and achieved fantastic results.

All of our GCSE results are first entry qualifications, GCSEs only with no equivalent qualifications counted.

English = 74% 9-4

Maths = 66% 9-4

Other subjects

GCSE Biology = 100% A*-C with 38% A*/A

GCSE Chemistry = 100% with 34% A*/A

GCSE Physics = 100% A*-C with 52% A*/A

GCSE D&T = 82% A*-C, with 37% A*/A

25% of our students achieved at least two or more A grades or higher

Our progress measures show that our students, on average, make at least the same and often better than expected progress at The Priory compared to the national picture. We are rightly proud of these results.

Our school intake is fully comprehensive and we offer places to all young people in the area regardless of academic ability or faith. Academic achievement is the most important area of our work as it opens doors to our students and gives them choices. This is supported by our strong Christian ethos and distinctiveness, ensuring our students are educated for life in all its fullness.
