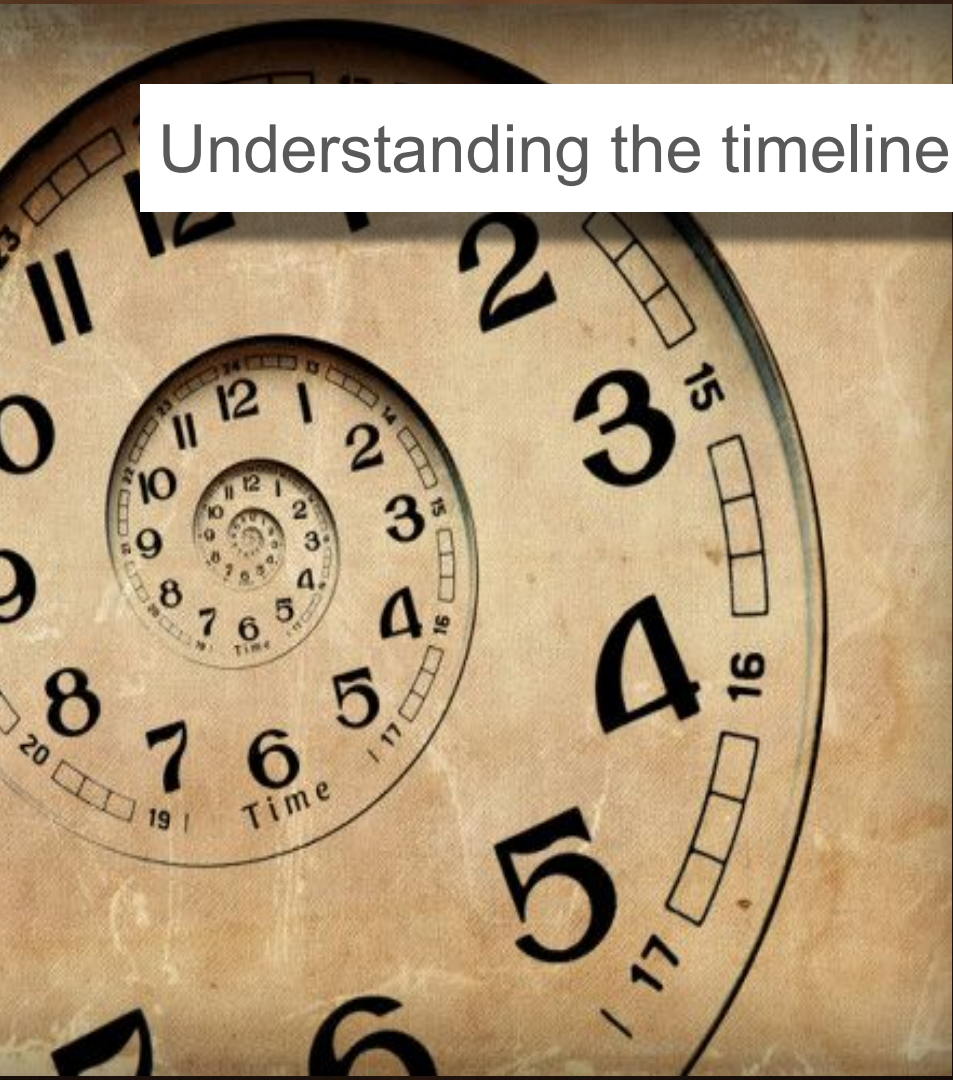
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What do we know already?

- Teacher assessed grades (TAGs)
- Clearly identified and shared evidence base
- 18th June submission of TAGs
- Early results days

Understanding the timeline and rationale



Rationale

- Early opportunities for objective assessments
 - A second series of assessments to provide multiple opportunities for students to demonstrate their progress
 - Remove the pressure of one key assessment point
 - Give students the chance to continue to learn from feedback and to demonstrate this learning
- Coursework/NEAs marked grades returned to students over the coming term
 - Mock exams using majoritively unseen external papers and exam board mark schemes
 - Mock marks shared with students and parents /carers and feedback given to each student during w/b 3rd May
 - In class assessment week primarily using the exam board question bank developed specifically for TAGs during w/b 24th May
 - Assessment marks shared with students and parents/carers after May half term
